Nachiketa Tapovan (NT) is a non-profit organization established in 1999, dedicated to uplifting underprivileged and marginalized communities who struggle to meet their basic needs.

NT believes in the transformative power of basic, scientific, and value-based education, equipping students to navigate life's challenges and achieve their aspirations. NT looks upon all the students as a manifestation of divine holding immense potential, irrespective of their caste, creed, community, gender or religion.

Operating two centres—one nestled in Hyderabad's Kavuri Hills and another in the remote Kodgal village, Mahabubnagar—NT provides free education to disadvantaged children in surrounding areas. No fees are charged for education, and students receive free books, school kits, and other essentials. Currently, over 600+ children benefit from NT's initiative, with classes spanning from Nursery to 10<sup>th</sup> Grade under the affiliation of the Telangana State Secondary School Board.

By the year 2024, 175 students have successfully cleared their 10<sup>th</sup> Grade examinations with outstanding results, many of whom are pursuing higher education. NT supports deserving students in their higher studies. Some of the first batch alumni realized their dreams by completing professional degrees like Engineering and securing positions in multinational corporations, thereby transforming their lives and those of their families. They stand out as the testimony of the success of NT's mission envisioned years ago.



NT's mission is bolstered by the generous support of individuals and corporations who contribute through monetary donations, resources, and volunteerism, enriching the educational experience. Besides academics, NT places a strong emphasis on holistic development, offering training in sports, arts, and cultural activities. Environmental education is also prioritized, fostering awareness among children about environmental protection, pollution control, and sustainable practices such as waste management and tree plantation.

Moreover, NT provides opportunities for children to interact with individuals from diverse backgrounds, enabling them to learn from varied experiences and knowledge. This holistic approach ensures that NT children not only excel academically but also grow into responsible citizens prepared to contribute positively to the society.



## RATIONALE FOR THE PROJECT

At the Mahabubnagar centre, we currently have 12 classrooms accommodating 342 children from Nursery to 10th grade. In addition, there are 3 rooms serving as a Computer lab, Staff room, and Principal's office. However, our current infrastructure struggles to fully support the needs of higher grade levels.

Recognizing the pressing need to upgrade our facilities and provide modern amenities such as Science Labs, Language Labs, and a Library, we have undertaken the decision to construct a new building. This initiative aims not only to meet the growing demands of our student but also extends its impact to empower other school students by providing access to cutting-edge facilities, thereby equipping them for future success."

- ❖ To share the state-of-the-art infrastructure with other schools from the vicinity

## PROJECT DETAILS

The proposed building with G+2 floor will be made up of RCC structure with an area of 25550 sft. It houses Science, Maths and Language labs and Arts & Crafts centre, along with space for Administration.

Scientific labs will be equipped with state-of-the-art equipment. It will also have a refreshment room, recreation hall, and standby room for medical support.

Infrastructure is designed in such a way that it is easily accessible and convenient for the physically challenged people as well.

It also will have an open amphitheatre with sitting capacity of 500.

Building is in the midst of green cover.

Workshop houses, Plumbing, Electrical, Carpentry, Fabrication and various Vocational training courses.

Outdoor science park is to conduct scientific experiments in an interactive way.

The proposed School building will comply with all safety standards that includes Fire exit staircases, Fire extinguisher and will be designed to be environmentally sustainable.

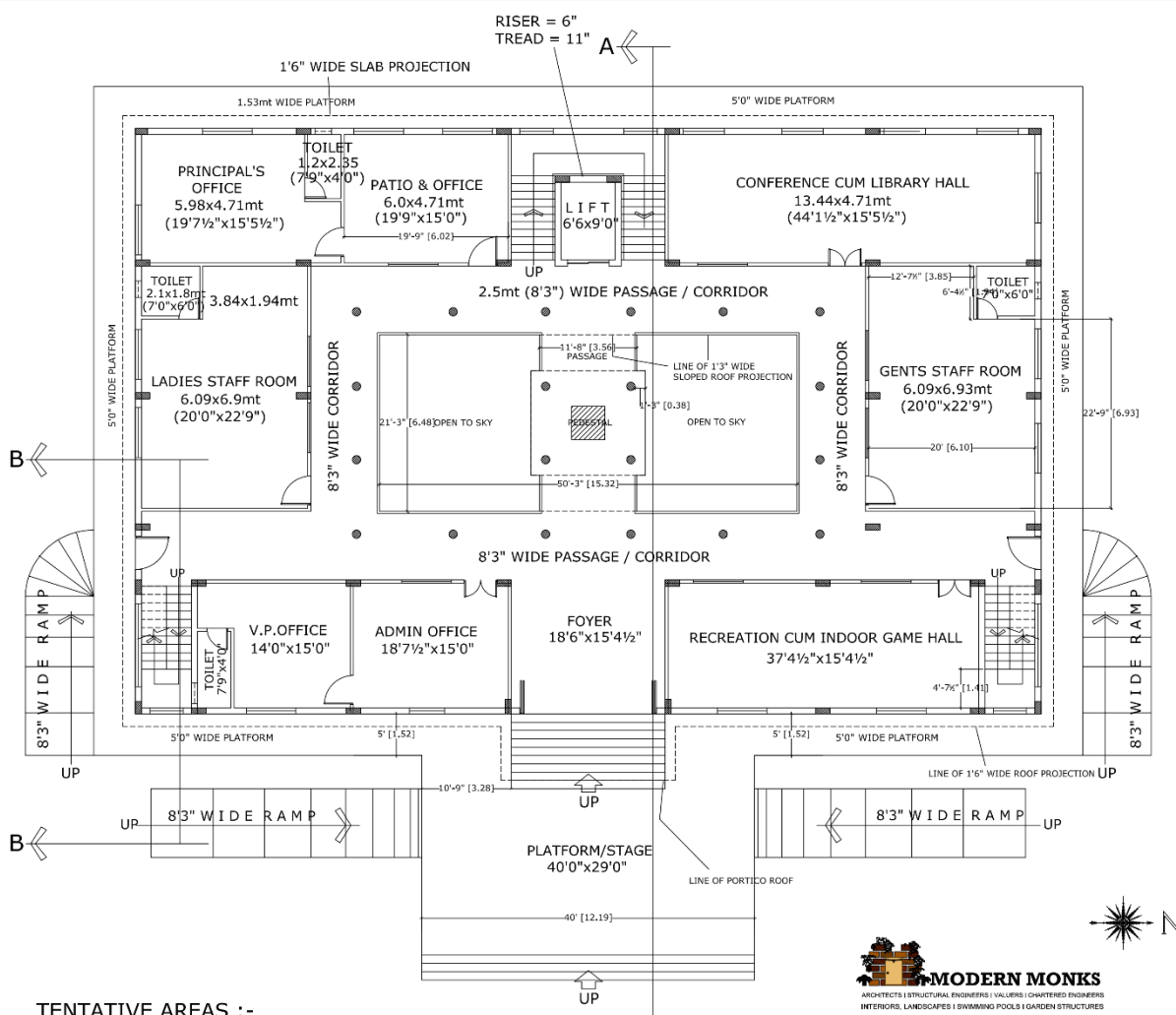

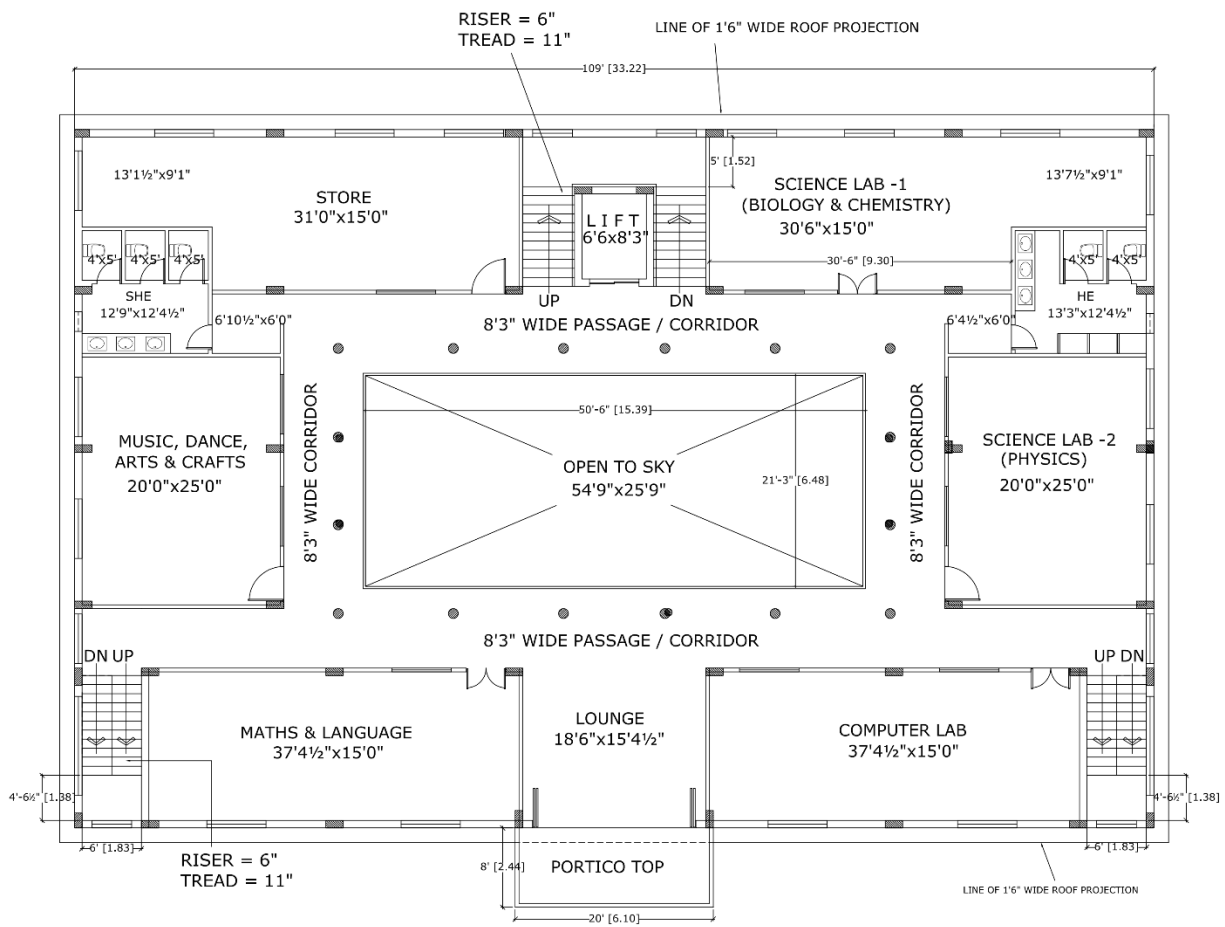

**SCHOOL BLOCK**

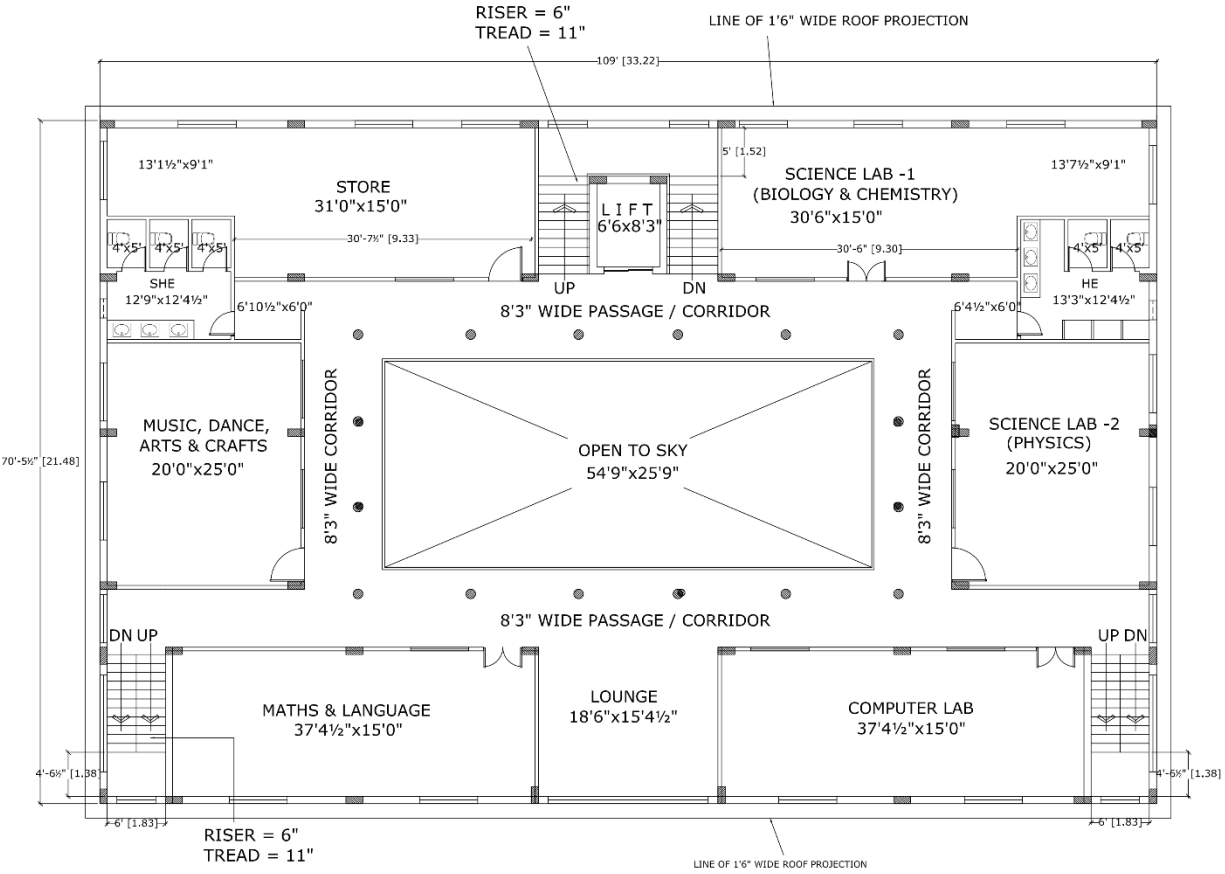
